A final note

The year 2007 started great for me with James Bach and Michael Bolton hiring me. I had a little doubt if I deserved it but I said to myself, “If I don’t deserve it today, I should work hard to ensure I deserve it at least by the end of the year” and today on January 1 2008, I feel, I deserve it. I didn’t misuse or rest myself the credits that I had been bestowed with. Some people continue to say that I have been lucky and I know what a perfect joke they crack because I don’t think luck can be as continuous as how it appeared to be for me.

I needed financial support at the start of the year 2007 but passion and hard work, over a period of time ensured that I become one of the highest paid tester for my age category in India. At the start of the year, I had to rely on James Bach and Michael Bolton for a laptop, chair and table to work but as days progressed I earned enough to buy a car, home and I plan for a travel to Canada in July 08 to attend CAST 08 conference. When I asked Michael, “*What should I return back to you?*”, he said something like, “*I passed it on to you and I think you should pass it on, too, which I think you are doing*”. I spend enough of my time and money in educating testers, teaching them for free, gifting books to deserving ones and helping them to think to solve their own problems.

I think this is what happened to me: I realized that if I do 20 things, 1 out of 20 comes out great. I wanted to do 100 great things, so the only way I could do it is to do 2000 things. In doing 2000 things, I learned why I could see a great output in only 1 out of 20 attempts and not in all 20.
